

REQUESTS FOR QUOTATION – 2026-06
ANNUAL PULVERIZE, PREP & PAVE

The Township of Nipigon is requesting quotations to pulverize, prepare & pave the following sections of roadway;

- 400m (L) x 8m (W) section of Greenmantle Drive (Between Bliss Road and end of existing asphalt)
- 225m (L) x 9m (W) section of Bell Street (Between 5th & 7th)
- 150m (L) x 9m (W) section of 9th Street (Between McKirdy Avenue and Railway Street)

Proposed Scope of Work

The finished asphalt surface shall consist of 50mm SP 12.5 with a minimum anticipated 2% crown.

The successful contractor shall pulverize the existing roadway and, following pulverization, participate in a site review with the Township to determine whether localized road base repairs are required prior to paving.

Historically the Township has completed any required road base repairs using internal forces. However as part of this RFQ, bidders are requested to provide separate pricing for completing any road base repairs that may be identified by the Township following pulverization. The township reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to complete the road base repairs with its own forces or to award all or part of the road base repair work to the successful Contractor.

Contractors shall include:

- Pricing for pulverizing the roadway
- Pricing for supply and placing 50mm of SP 12.5 asphalt
- Separate pricing for road base repairs (to be performed on a unit rate or hourly basis as identified below).
- Separate pricing identifying mobilization costs if road base repairs are awarded to the Contractor in conjunction with the pulverizing and paving work.

Contractors are requested to specify whether the proposed asphalt placement will be completed in one lift or two lifts.

The Contractor should anticipate separate mobilizations for pulverizing and paving. If the Township elects to award the road base repair work to the Contractor, bidders shall identify any additional mobilization costs associated with completing that work.

Prior to paving, the successful Contractor shall complete a site inspection with the Township to confirm that the roadway base is suitable for asphalt placement.

Anticipated Schedule:

- Pulverizing – Late Summer 2026
- Road Base Repairs (by Township or Contractor, if awarded) – Late Summer 2026
- Asphalt Placement – No later than September 4, 2026

For a bid to be considered successful and/or accepted, the Township may request that the successful bidder enter into an agreement with the Township to ensure that the work is completed up to the necessary standards and specifications.
