SUBJECT: Addendum No. 1 (Clarification – Road Base Repairs)

DATE: July 9, 2026

The Township of Nipigon is issuing this Addendum No. 1 to provide clarification regarding the road base repairs for RFQ 2026-06 Annual Pulverize, Prep and Pave.

Question 1 – Scope for Road Base Repairs

The intent of the road base repair item is to provide for localized repairs to the pulverized roadway where, in the opinion of the Township's representative, the existing road base is determined to be unsuitable for paving.

Road base repairs may include, but are not limited to:

- Excavation and removal of unsuitable or unstable material following pulverization;
- Supply, placement, watering (if required), and compaction of Granular "A" material to restore the roadway to the required grade and crossfall;
- Fine grading to establish the required crown and roadway profile in preparation for paving.

The quantity and location of road base repairs cannot be determined in advance and will vary depending on existing site conditions encountered after pulverization. Accordingly:

- Road base repairs will be completed only where directed by the Township.
- Payment will be made based on the applicable unit rates submitted in the Contractor's bid and the actual quantities completed and accepted by the Township.
- Bidders shall include all labour, equipment, materials, hauling, grading, compaction, and all other incidentals necessary to complete the work.
- **The Township does not guarantee any minimum or maximum quantity of road base repairs under this contract.**

Question 2 – Intent on Streets with Curbs

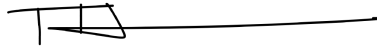
The intent of the contract is to reuse the pulverized asphalt and granular material to the greatest extent practical by grading and shaping it to achieve the required roadway profile and crown in

preparation for paving.

Where excess pulverized material must be removed to achieve the required roadway profile or where unsuitable material is excavated as part of directed road base repairs, the Contractor shall remove and haul the excess material to a Township-designated disposal location within the Township limits. No tipping fees will apply at the designated disposal site.

All other terms, conditions, and specifications of the RFQ remain unchanged.
